The NIS including the plans will be available for inspection free of charge, during the period from 2nd June 2021 to 16th July 2021 inclusive.

Submissions or observations with respect to the proposed development may be made in writing to the An Bord Pleanála in relation to

- i. the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development;
- ii. the implications of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development in the area in which it is proposed to situate the proposed development; and
- iii. the likely significant effects of the proposed development on a European Site, If carried out.
