LAOIS COUNTY COUNCIL

Significant Further Information has been furnished to Laois County Council, under Planning Reference Number 22/48 on behalf of Tim & Gillian Fitzgerald at Redhill, Co. Laois. The proposed works will consist of: Quarry activities for the extraction of sand and gravel within a total area of 4.7ha with an excavation area of 3.7ha site at Redhill, Co. Laois over a ten year period. On site equipment would include a dry screener, loading shovel, a dumper as required, an excavator as required and a concrete wheel wash at entrance. Provision of temporary chemical toilets, temporary canteen and welfare facilities near the existing site entrance. Removal of hedgerow near the existing sight entrance to increase sightlines. A concrete hardstand area in the northeast corner of the site draining to a silt trap and interceptor is proposed to prevent any release of fuel to ground. Surface water drainage across the site is proposed to prevent sediment run off, off site or fuel run off to ground. Dispatch of the processed materials off-site is proposed via Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs) using a one way traffic system. A fenced off buffer zone of 10m between the existing hedgerow and proposed excavation area has been allowed for to protect the hedgerows locally important ecological value. A restoration plan has been included in the application which will reinstate the site to agricultural use at the end of the project. An Environmental and Planning Report, Ecological Impact Assessment Report, Appropriate Assessment Screening Report and detailed site drawings have been included as part of this planning application. Significant Further Information/Revised Plans have been furnished to the planning authority in respect of this proposed development, and are available for inspection or purchase at the offices of the authority during its public opening hours. A submission or observation in relation to the further information or revised plans may be made in writing to the planning authority on payment of the prescribed fee of €20, except in the case of a person or body who has already made a submission or observation, not later than 2 weeks after the receipt of the newspaper notice and site notice by the planning authority.

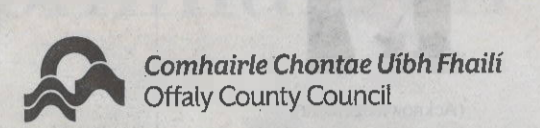

We, EirGrid plc with the consent and approval of the Electricity Supply Board (ESB) is applying to Offaly County Council for permission for works associated with the proposed uprate of the existing 110 kV line in the townlands of Bishopswood and Tinacranagh, County Offaly. The Proposed Development (uprate) within the functional area of Offaly County Council relates to approximately 1.6 km of the 110kV line and comprises: the replacement ("restringing") of the existing overhead line circuit conductor and wires with new higher capacity conductor wires including installation of a new fibre communication connection; the replacement of 1 no. wooden polesets and 1 no. steel masts - any replacement Structures will be constructed at, or immediately adjacent to the existing Structures they will replace. They will be along the same alignment as existing, the height difference will be up to 4m and they will be of a generally similar appearance, unless otherwise stated; the replacement of crossarms at 1 no. wooden polesets; the replacement of hardware and fittings such as suspension clamps, insulators, and vibration dampeners at all Structures, as required; re-capping and remedial works for shear blocks at 1 no. steel mast; installation of bird flight diverters; all associated site development works, including foundation upgrade works and strain assemblies; all associated temporary site development works to gain access to the existing Structures including clearance of vegetation, disassembly and reassembly of gate posts / piers and removal and reinstatement of existing fencing; and other temporary associated and ancillary development works required for the purpose of the uprate of the existing circuit, including temporary guard poles, construction compounds, the installation of silt traps, silt fences, stone tracks, ground protection mats and temporary watercourse crossings. The Proposed Development is part of a larger project which includes uprate works to approximately 20 km of 110kV line within the functional area of Laois County Council for which a separate planning application has been lodged with Laois County Council. A Natura Impact Statement (NIS) has been prepared in respect of the proposed development. The planning application and Natura Impact Statement may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the offices of the Planning Authority, during its public opening hours. A submission or observation in relation to the application may be made in writing to the Planning Authority on payment of the prescribed fee of €20.00 within the period of five (5) weeks beginning on the date of receipt by the Planning Authority of the planning application, and such submissions or observations will be considered by the Authority in making a decision on the application. 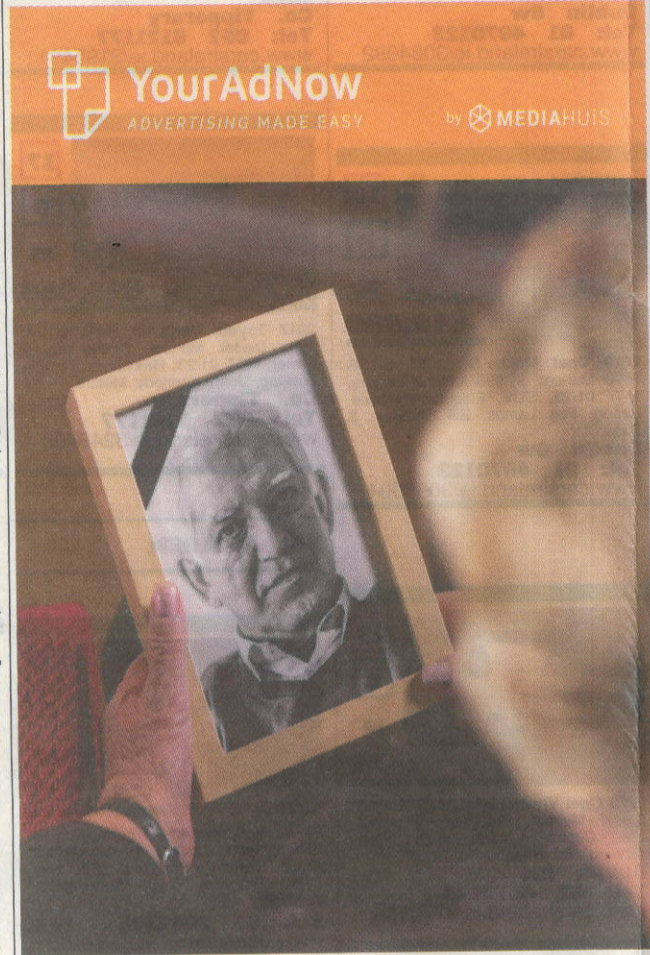
