

**EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE JULY MEETING OF LAOIS  
COUNTY COUNCIL HELD ON THE 27<sup>TH</sup> OF JULY 2020**

**Part VIII of the Local Government Planning & Development Regulations,  
2001 (documentation enclosed) in respect of the construction of:**

- (i) 67 voluntary housing units
- (ii) Public Car Park, and
- (iii) Associated site development works at Station Road, Portlaoise

On the proposition of Councillor Thomasina Connell seconded by Councillor John Joe Fennelly, the Members unanimously agreed to the proposed development consisting of the construction of a residential development of a total of 67 dwelling units, consisting of 30 houses and 37 apartments over 3 Blocks at Railway Street, Portlaoise, Co. Laois with a new access road from Railway Street at the existing entrance to Maryville House from Millbrook. The development will also include a new 94 space public car park.
